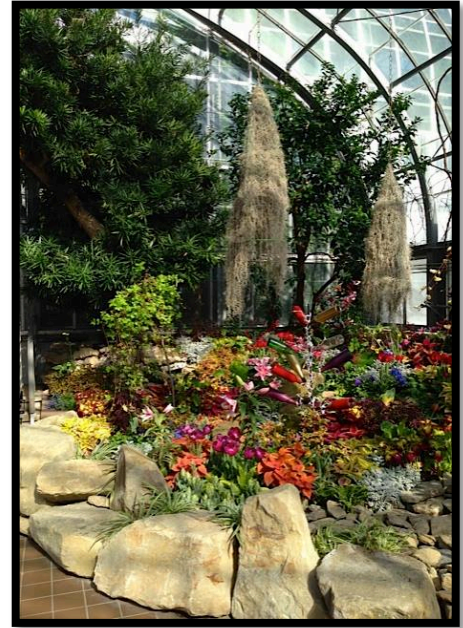


Since the Krohn Conservatory is a hot spot for weddings, parties and tourists of Cincinnati, let's take a look at how this hot spot came to be a major part of this city.

In the 1880s, Eden Park had multiple small greenhouses that were used strictly for growing plants. A new greenhouse was designed to host public displays. The first show of chrysanthemums was so popular that the Park Board decided to have continually changing displays of a variety of plants to attract new visitors, thus, the start of the Krohn Conservatory.



The conservatory was completed in 1933 and was originally known as the Eden Park Greenhouse. In 1937, it was renamed to the Krohn Conservatory to honor Irwin M. Krohn, who served as Board of Park Commissioner from 1912 to 1948.

Krohn has become a focal point of Cincinnati and is a nationally recognized showcase of more than 3,500 species of plants from around the world. No matter what the weather is outside, exotic flowers and plants inside will always surround your event.
